

## The BIOL 103 Web Project -- 2007

Your Web Project will present an investigation or story of biological phenomena, on Earth or elsewhere. Two partners may share a project, with the amount of work increased appropriately.

In this Folder: \\internal.kenyon.edu\bio103                      Each project must include:

- Principles of biology
- An original mathematical calculation with numbers presented as part of the story.

Your project **MUST** meet the following guidelines. **This signed checklist, with all boxes checked, MUST be turned in with your project, SIGNED by both authors:**

- The entire project resides in its own named folder in the class directory.
- A backup exists in your own H:
- The introductory filename is titled: "**index.html**" or "**welcome.html**". This is a conventional standard for professional publishing on the Web.
- None** of the filenames contain empty spaces. Instead use underscore: no\_space.htm.
- Only letters and numbers** in filenames--no punctuation marks.
- Every image borrowed from on line includes the site name and hyperlink to the original site.
- Every image scanned from a book includes full bibliographic citation, with link to the publisher on line if possible.
- A standard reference page, based on MLA or scientific bibliographic citation, including all web and book sources, is linked to the index (introduction) page.
- All text pasted from web sites or copied from books is in quotes. Failure to do so constitutes plagiarism.** Student projects will be Googled for evidence of copying.
- All links work (yes, every one on every page). **Ask a friend to read it.**
- No viruses.** Scan your folder with the standard Kenyon antivirus program.
- The project version in the class folder works in **Firefox** on a networked non-Mac Kenyon PC **other than the one you wrote it on.** This ensures that none of the files or images are "trapped" on your own hard drive, and that it will work on the Hig Aud PC.
